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



#### The Four Answers - Visual Guide


**I ACCEPT** 

The subject is the predicate




#### WHY?

The subject is not the predicate/give proof that the subject is the predicate




#### **REASON'S NOT TRUE**

The subject is not the reason (the reason is not established within the subject)



#### **NO PERVASION**

There is no pervasion between the reason and the predicate (if it's the reason, it's not necessarily the predicate)




#### THE THREE LIMBS OF A FLAWLESS REASON

#### **All Three Limbs:**




- 1. A flower is a product

- 3. If it is **not** impermanent it is necessarily **not** a product.








#### **Flow of Debate**


The small chart below is a bird's eye view on the flow of a simple debate

#### **How to Count the Joints of Debate**

The assertions here are made from the perspective of the Nalanda Tradition.

Note that for equivalence and contradiction there may *sometimes* be something that is neither (a) nor (b), but the convention is not to count that as a separate Joint.

(a) Form and (b) External Matter have...

3 Joints.



If it is (a) form, it is necessarily (b) external matter.


If it is (b) external matter, it is not necessarily (a) form.

There is something that is neither.

- 1. Something which is both
  - = the color white
- 2. Something which is (b) external matter but not (a) form
  - = the word "OK"
- 3. Something which is neither (a) form nor (b) external matter
  - = unicorns

## (a) Form and (b) One (aka a singular object) have...

#### 4 Joints.



If it is (a) form, it is not necessarily (b) one.

If it is (b) one, it is not necessarily (a) form.

There is something that is both.

There is something that is neither.

- 1. Something which is both
  - = the color white
- 2. Something which is (a) Form but not (b) One:
  - = the colors red and white
- 3. Something which is (b) One but not (a) Form
  - = the eye consciousness
- 4. Something which is neither (a) Form nor (b) One
  - = the eye consciousness and the ear consciousness

## (a) Form and (b) an object seen in the domain of visual consciousness are...


#### **Equivalent.**



If it is (a) form, it is necessarily (b) an object seen in the domain of visual consciousness.

If it is (b) an object seen in the domain of visual consciousness, it is necessarily (a) Form.

  - = the shape of an elephant.
- (a) Form and (b) Consciousness are... contradictory.



If it is (a) form, it is necessarily **not** (b) consciousness.

If it is (b) consciousness, it is necessarily **not** (a) form.

- 1. Something which is (a) Form but not (b) Consciousness:
  - = the color red
- 2. Something which is (b) consciousness but not (a) Form
  - = the eye consciousness.

## TEMPLATE The Joints of Reasoning

#### **EQUIVALENCE:**



C: It follows that you can posit the difference between (a) a cat and (b) a feline, in terms of *Three Joints, Four Joints, Equivalence, or Contradiction*.

D: I accept.

C: Posit it.

D: Equivalence.

#### [asking for reason for equivalence]

C: Take the subject: a cat and a feline. They are equivalent because...?

D: Because they have the eight doors of pervasion.

#### [the eight doors of pervasion]

[the two doors of being]

- (1) if it is a cat, it is necessarily a feline
- (2) if it is a feline, it necessarily is a cat.

#### [the two doors of non-being]

- (3) If it is not a cat, it is necessarily not a feline
- (4) if it is **not** a feline, it necessarily is **not** a cat.

[the two doors of existence]


- (5) If it has a cat, it necessarily has a feline
- (6) if it has a feline, it necessarily has a cat.

[the two doors of non-equivalence]

- (7) If it doesn't have a cat, it necessarily doesn't have a feline
- (8) if it doesn't have a feline, it necessarily doesn't have a cat.

[examples are not needed for equivalent phenomena, but you may ask for them if you like.]

#### **CONTRADICTION:**



C: It follows that you can posit the difference between (a) a cat and (b) a dog in terms of *Three Joints, Four Joints, Equivalence, or Contradiction*.

D: I accept.

C: Posit it.

D: Contradiction.

C: Take the subject: a cat and a dog. They are contradictory because...?

D: Because they are distinct phenomena which have joint hub. (e.g., nothing which is both of them exists)

#### [confirming pervasions]


C: It follows that if it is a cat, then it is necessarily **not** a dog. D: I accept.

C: It follows that if it is a dog, then it is necessarily **not** a cat.

D: I accept.

[examples not needed for contradiction, but you ask for them if you like.]

#### **THREE JOINTS:**



C: It follows you can posit the difference between (a) a black cat and (b) a feline in terms of *Three Joints, Four Joints, Equivalence, or Contradiction*.

D: I accept.

C: Posit it.

D: Three Joints.

C: Which pervades which?

D: If it is a black cat, it is necessarily a feline. If it is a feline, it is not necessarily a black cat.

#### [confirming pervasion]

C: It follows that if it is a feline, then it is not necessarily a black cat.

D: I accept.

#### [examples]

C: Posit an example of something that is a feline and **not** a black cat.

D: Take the subject A white cat.

C: Take the subject: a white cat. It follows that it is a feline.

D: I accept.





Instructions: Decide who will be Challenger and who will be Defender.

Challenger reads the 3-Part Syllogism, beginning with "Take the subject," and then reads the written subject, predicate, and reason. The Defender responds by saying "No pervasion."

The Challenger then says "Restate the pervasion" and the Defender states the **negated** pervasion, (making sure to include the word "**not**" before the word "**necessarily**"). Add articles ("the, an, a") as you wish.

#### **EXAMPLE**

C: Take the subject: a kidney. It follows that it's life, because it has cells.

D: No pervasion!

C: Restate the pervasion.

D: If it has cells, it is not necessarily life.

<sup>\*</sup> Remember that some of the pervasions are valid while others are not, but here we're just doing an exercise to train in the habit of learning how to restate the pervasion.
